- Confirmation of whether you wish to speak in support or against an application or other matter.
- Confirmation of whether you are representing yourself or anyone else.
- Confirmation that we can provide your details to other people in the event that there are more than the allocated number of potential speakers. This is in order that you can agree which people will speak.
- Details of any special access or other arrangements that you may require.

A maximum of six people are invited to speak on each planning application or related matter, for example, three in support and three against. This number includes the applicants or agents speaking in their behalf (such as a local Parish, Town, District, Unitary or County Councillor).


