

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER
Highways Act 1980

West Sussex County Council (Fulking)
Public Path (No.4f Part) Diversion Order 2013

This order is made by West Sussex County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 below, it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Mr Gort-Barten of Perching Sands Farm, Edburton Road, Fulking and Mr Anthony Kenny of Field End, Greenways Ovingdean, Brighton have agreed to contribute towards any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public and to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order.

The Mid Sussex District Council and Natural England have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER

1. The public right of way over land situate at Fulking and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. Notwithstanding anything in paragraph 1 of this Order, where immediately before the date on which a highway is stopped up in pursuance of this Order there is apparatus on, under or over that highway belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus they then had.
3. There shall be at the end of 21 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Fulking described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.

SCHEDULE

Part 1

Description of site of existing path or way

Part of public footpath number 4f in the Parish of Fulking, commencing at a point approximately 210 metres north of Perching Sands House (grid ref 2402 1287) and extending southwards for approximately 270 metres, to the west side of Perching Sands House before heading east for approximately 20 metres (grid ref 2408 1260) then continuing south for approximately 185 metres as shown by the bold continuous line between points A and D on the attached plan number 01579A.
