District Plan – Submission

Mid Sussex District Council has formally submitted its District Plan to the Secretary of State. The District Plan is being produced jointly with South Downs National Park Authority.

The District Plan will now be subject to an independent public examination by a Planning Inspector who will hold a public hearing, the sessions of which are anticipated to take place during Autumn 2013. Once confirmed, all details relating to the examination process will be advertised, made available online and sent to those people who asked to be notified of the examination.




