Competition Rules

- Entrants of the competition are required to create a dish of choice using one mandatory ingredient. 500g of Beef Mince.
- 2) Entrants are required to purchase their own ingredients and cook their dish at home. On the night of competition space will be provided for heating, plating, and presenting your dish to the panel of judges
- 3) Dishes will be judged by the panel of judge's marks 1 – 10 on the following four categories:
- -Dish Originality -Dish Flavours -Dish Complexity -Dish Presentation
- 3) Once made, Judges Decisions will be final. In the event of a tie, Judges will vote for their favourite dish explaining why. It will be down to the Head Judge to have the casting vote.
- **4)** Competition entries will be accepted by the household. One entry per house.
- **5)** The sharing of information regarding each competition dish shall remain confidential until it has been presented to the panel of judges.
- 6) The winning chef will be presented with the Fulking Master Chef Trophy which will be engraved and remain at the pub.
