A change in the way you call local numbers

Ofcom is making a change to the way people in the Brighton area dial local numbers. From 1st October 2014, you'll need to add the 01273 area code before you call any local number from your home phone (just like you already do with national and other numbers or when you use your mobile). If you have any local numbers stored in your home phone, make sure you change them to include 01273 **today**. And don't forget to check any other equipment, such as personal or home alarm systems, that might connect to a local number. Check on elderly neighbours too.
