Public Footpath 4f

The DEFRA inspector charged with deciding whether this footpath should be rerouted has ruled that it should not be. He concluded "that the adverse effect on the public's enjoyment of the path if it were diverted in the manner proposed would be significant" and "the adverse effect on public enjoyment clearly outweighs the benefit .. to the landowners". The proposed diversions will thus not come into force. Instead, the historic route retains its status as a lawful right of way. He notes that the public right of way has been obstructed in the vicinity of Perching Sands House and that an unofficial path has been provided which passes some ten metres to the west of the house. Further, the Definitive Statement for the path does not list any stiles or gates as lawful limitations on the public's use.
