...stands for the Ouse & Adur Rivers Trust and they want to alert us to the dangers of phosphates in streams around Fulking. These days phosphates get into streams and rivers mainly from cleaning materials such as dishwasher detergents, food via the sewerage system, as well as farm run-off. Phosphates are plant nutrients that envourage algae growth which in turn reduces oxygen supply in rivers. The solution? Start by switching to phosphate free cleaning products and watch our rivers improve. More at oart.org.uk.
