Free, sociable, family friendly walks led by volunteers. No need to book, just turn-up.

Health Walks are aimed at beginners and those with long term health conditions. Under 1.5 hours over easy terrain. Health Walks are supported by Walking for Health (accredited by the national Walking for Health scheme managed by the Ramblers & Macmillan Cancer Support).

Level 2 and 3 Walks are longer, more strenuous and may include hills and stiles. These walks are supported by Horsham District Council and some are organised in conjunction with groups such as Steyning Downland Scheme and Storrington Conservation Society.

A volunteer walk leader will be at the start of the walk whatever the weather. However, we reserve the right to change or cancel a walk without notice. Walk leaders are supported by HDC and we expect them to be treated with respect at all times.
