Rules of the Board

- 1. Anyone may post anything*.
- 2. All notices must be **dated**, either with a posting date written on the front of the notice, or else by a printed event date (e.g., the date of a concert). Undated and out-of-date notices will be removed.
- 3. Notices should not exceed **A4** in size. Larger notices will most likely be removed. Ceteris paribus, if space is tight, A5 (and smaller) notices will take precedence over A4 notices.
- 4. You may only remove, alter, or replace **your own** notices.
- 5. The two public Fulking notice boards (bus shelter and village hall) are **not** mutually exclusive. You are free to post the same notice to both.
- 6. This board is maintained by a **board warden**. The board warden can remove any notice at any time for any reason.
- 7. The board warden's decisions are **final**.

*Where 'anything' includes, at least, agendas, athletic events, bluebells, book sales, cancellations, car boots, carol singing, children, church events, classes, concerts, crafts, dog walkers, drama, election notices, exhibitions, farm events, fireworks, footpaths, fund raising, games evenings, garage sales, hang gliding, help needed, horticultural shows, ironing, items for free, items for sale, items wanted, jobs, kites, kittens, local produce, minutes, missing cats, mountain bikes, National Trust events, neighbourhood watch alerts, North Town Field matters, open gardens, parking issues, parties, pet minders, photos, plant sales, police wanted posters, Poynings events, Preston Nomads, public transport, quizzes, rehearsals, road closure warnings, S&D events, services, talks, teenagers, toddlers, tradesmen, unicorns, vegetable stalls, village fêtes, walks, Woods Mill events, WSCT clippings, xylophone lessons, yoga, and zebra husbandry.
