Temporary closure of Clappers Lane, Fulking CP, 15th December 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Clappers Lane, Fulking CP, in the Mid Sussex District under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Clappers Lane for a distance approx 239 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 15th December 2021 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 17th December 2021) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Southern Water undertakes 24hr Road Closure between the junctions of Holmbush Lane to Edburtons Road with works taking place outside property Wellington House to repair a leak on a fire hydrant

The restriction will be in place **24hrs**

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
