Fulking Parish Council News by Mark Hind, Chair of Fulking PC

Below is an update on some hot topics:

Full Fibre Broadband Scheme

The project has been given the go ahead by Openreach following an agreement from Poynings Parish Council to cover any shortfall. Although in the end we were 8 properties over the pledges needed it was 3 under after validation. It will take about 12 months for the project to be delivered and it is important that all who have pledged sign up for their fibre contracts when it is available.

Fulking Village Hall Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO)

As part of the plan to eventually buy the village hall from the Church, the Fulking Village Hall CIO has been set up, which is registered with the Charity Commission. This CIO was set up following advice from the Sussex branch of Action with Communities in Rural England (ACRE) who suggested this would be the best structure to run the hall and secure it as an asset for the community. We are still waiting for final approval from the Church regarding the sale. The current Co-Chairs of the Village Hall Action Group are two of the Trustees of this new charity, and it has been suggested that the current VHAG operation of the hall is moved into this new charity.

Ladybrook Spring

West Sussex County Council undertook temporary repairs to stop the flow of water across the road. A date for the permanent repairs has yet to be advised but we are hopeful this will be some time this year.
